John Jacobchick, as cemetery sexton, has extensive experience in the cemetery and funeral management areas and is readily available to all regarding cemetery matters. Along with John and his crew, volunteers remain a huge part of the cemetery maintenance effort. Volunteer service exceeded 500 hours this past season and included grass cutting, trimming, grave leveling and putting sod on new gravesites, as well as trash pickup. We are thankful for the major contribution they have made to the improved appearance of the cemetery. Next year, we are looking for 3 to 4 new volunteers to trim around gravesites.
